# How to get a marriage license in Racine County

## WHAT YOU'LL NEED

Proof of age. Bring a certified copy of your birth certificate (the hospital record with your little footprints won't work).

Proof of residence. Use your driver's license or state-issued ID. It must have your current address on it. If it doesn't, bring a phone, cable or

electric bill addressed to your current address.

Proof you're single. If you were previously married and it ended in death of your spouse, bring the death certificate. If the marriage ended in divorce, you'll need

the divorce judgment showing a divorce was granted and filed in court. You must be divorced at least six months before you can remarry.

## **KNOW THE FACTS**

Once at the clerk's office, you will need to provide:

■ Social Security numbers of you and your spouse-to-be.

■ The name, address and phone number of the person performing your ceremony.

Your wedding date.

■ The name and address of your ceremony location.

### **GET THE CASH**

A marriage license costs \$90 in Racine

County, cash only.

# HEAD TO THE COURTHOUSE

Apply at the Racine County Clerk's office, on the first floor of the courthouse, 730 Wisconsin Ave. The office is open 8 a.m.-5 p.m.

Monday-Friday.

Applications are also accepted at the Western Racine County Service Center, 209 N. Main St., Burlington.

Arrive before 4:30 p.m. It takes about 20 minutes to fill out the forms.

Apply two weeks before your wedding. If you apply on a Monday, your license will be available the following Monday.

Once the license is issued, you need to use it within 30 days.
